PR-N3201 is a durable 5 mils, conformable self-wound polyethylene film with an aggressive acrylic adhesive for use in screen printing. It applies to both sides of screen, forming an adhesive bond, resisting attack by inks and cleaning solvents. It provides clean removal in one piece from wood frames and screen with no adhesive residue and can withstand multiple washings. PR-N3201 is all weather U.V. resistant for 30 days.

- General purpose screen block out tape to prevent ink from creeping between screen and frame
- General masking where high adhesion is required

Storage & Usage Conditions

Store tape in its original packaging away from direct sunlight and in a cool and dry area. For optimum performance, tape should be used within 12 months of date of shipment. Tape works best when applied to a surface that is clean, dry and free of grease, oil or other contaminants.
